CITY OF INCHEON – HUB OF NORTHEAST ASIA





PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Inha University Summer School offers students the opportunity to earn academic credits while immersing themselves in Korean culture. The three-week program combines engaging coursework with cultural excursions and hands-on experiences that highlight both traditional and contemporary aspects of Korea.

Since 2004, Inha University has been at the forefront of global education with its annual summer school program. Evolving each year, the program now offers a dynamic short-term, intensive experience that combines classroom lectures, site visits, cultural excursions, and hands-on activities. Participants will gain insights into the dynamic aspects of Korean society—past, present, and future—while earning academic credits and receiving certificates of completion upon concluding the program.

Additionally, students will have numerous opportunities to interact with Korean assistant students and engage with fellow international students. The program is designed to foster meaningful cultural exchanges by allowing participants to share their experiences and perspectives through courses, excursions, and various activities outside the classroom.

仁荷大学暑期学校 (Inha University Summer School) 自2004年创办以来, 已发展成为深受国际学生欢迎的高质量短期学术项目之一。每年均吸引来自世界各地的学生参加, 在为期三周的密集课程中, 获得充实而富有意义的学术与文化体验。2026年项目为期三周 (2026年7月27日 – 8月14日), 采用全英文授课形式。学生将在优质的教学环境中学习, 通过系统化课堂教学与丰富多彩的文化体验活动, 深入了解韩国社会的传统底蕴与现代发展。项目顺利完成, 学生可获得正式学术学分及结业证书。此外, 项目期间学生将与韩国学生助教 (Program Buddy) 密切交流, 并与来自不同国家和地区的同学建立友谊, 在多元文化环境中开展有意义的国际交流与合作。

二、项目特色
